Screening	 Instructors and students will be asked if they have any symptoms of fever, sore throat, cough, runny nose or difficulty breathing before being allowed into the building/classroom Anyone who is sick with cold-like symptoms such as cough, fever, runny nose, sore throat or shortness of breath, MUST NOT be in the building/classroom. Instructors or students with any of these symptoms will not be allowed in the building/classroom and will be advised to return home. As per the rental facility, each person entering the building MUST sign in with name and contact phone number.
Hand Hygiene and Respiratory Etiquette	• Instructors will promote and facilitate frequent and proper hand hygiene for the students. Sanitizer will be available at points of entry and locations throughout the location.
	• Instructors will encourage students to wash their hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer throughout the instruction day.
	• Instructors will make every effort to encourage respiratory etiquette (e.g., coughing or sneezing into a bent elbow, promptly disposing of used tissues in a lined garbage bin).
	 Instructors and students will be asked to comply with local bylaws regarding mandatory mask wearing.
Physical Distancing	Physical distancing will be facilitated with students being 2 metres apart at their tables.

	Class size will be limited to 10 students, with one instructor.
Shared Surfaces	High-touch/shared surfaces such as: doorknobs, light switches, toilet handles, faucets and taps, desktops, will be frequently cleaned and wiped down with disinfectant wipes.

	Communal materials provided by the instructor (where applicable) will be disinfected before and after each use whenever possible.
Other: Food	No food or beverages will be provided. Each student will be responsible for any food or drink items they would like to bring, and all garbage will be disposed of in a lined garbage bin.
